

Getting to St Andrews

From Edinburgh

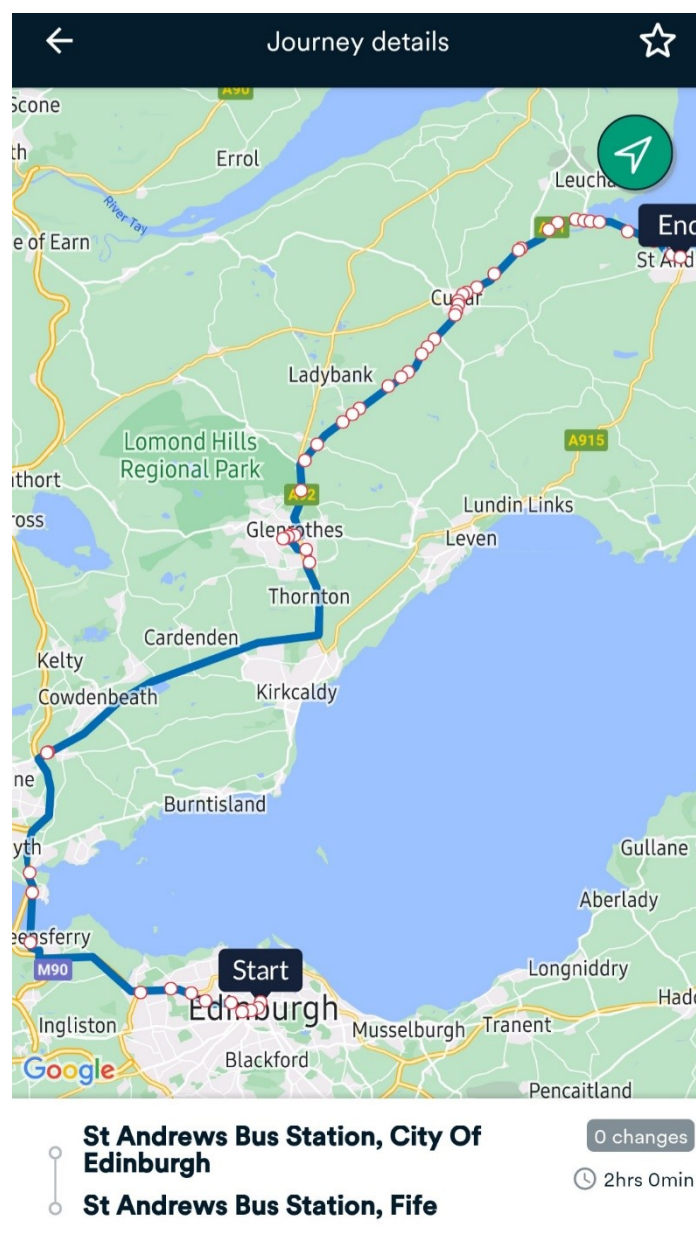
Bus.

[X59](#) Stagecoach Service runs from Edinburgh Bus Station (located on Elder Street in the city centre) directly to St Andrews Bus Station.

If you opt for this method, you will need you will need to travel into the city centre.

The Edinburgh Tram will take you to St Andrews Square, or the [100 Airlink](#) bus also regularly runs all day.

Stagecoach bus tickets can be purchased from the driver as a single fare using cash, or contactless card payments.



Getting to St Andrews

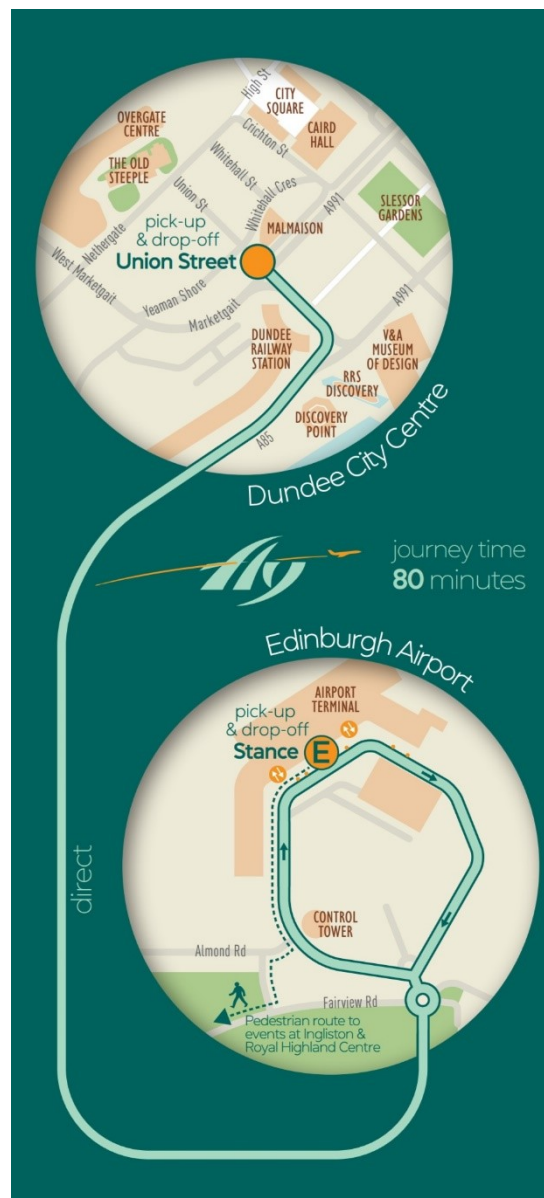
Please note that this is not the only Stagecoach bus service from Edinburgh to St Andrews, and you may also see the X58 or X60 bus services for St Andrews.

These services follow the full coast before arriving at St Andrews, so this is a very slow option (at least another 90minutes on top of the alternative service) so we would not recommend this.

None of these Stagecoach services run all night, so if your flight arrives later in the evening or is delayed then this may not be an option. In this scenario, you can consider the FLY [Airport Transfer](#).

This service departs Edinburgh Airport and goes directly to Dundee city centre, in 80 minutes. From there, you can take the 99 Bus Service (stagecoach) from outside the rail station to St Andrews Bus Station.

This can often still end up being a quicker option than the direct bus to St Andrews Bus Station if it coincides with your flight arrival time.



Getting to St Andrews

Train to Leuchars

Rail journey planner [here](#).

The tram is the easiest and quickest way to get to the train stations from Edinburgh Airport. As the tram runs every 7 minutes most of the day, there is no need to pre-book your ticket.

Edinburgh gateway is the closest train station to the airport, but it only offers an hourly service to Leuchars,

Edinburgh Haymarket is the alternative, with LNER and Cross Country services also running from here to Leuchars.

Downloading either the [ScotRail](#) or [National Rail](#) app will give you live times on the journey planner, so if you are opting for rail travel then either one of these will be helpful in your planning.

Travelling from Leuchars Train Station.

99 Bus Service.

This is a regular bus service that is operated by Stagecoach, which will call in at Leuchars rail station and takes you into St Andrews Bus Station. The journey time takes approximately 11-15mins (depending on traffic levels)

You can also use the Moffat & Williamson bus service from the station in Leuchars to St Andrews.

The Bus Station in St Andrews is locations a few minutes walk from the town centre, so very conveniently located.

Taxi.

Due to the size of St Andrews and surrounding areas, Uber/Bolt etc. does not operate in this area.

There are numerous taxi companies, all of which have drivers throughout the day at the taxi rank outside the train station in Leuchars. You can pick up the next available car, or you may wish to call ahead to a local provider to arrange pick-up – in this case, they will greet you at the pick up point.
